Inter 1 The Reporting Template shall be used by companies to report on their application of the provisions of the Code of Corporate Governance Practices for Issuers of Securities to the Public 2015 (the Code). The completion of the Reporting Template and its filing with the Capital Markets Authority (CMA) will fulfill the reporting requirements of the Code at 1.1.3 paragraph 2. All elements marked in green are mandatory and MUST be complied with. Failure to fully apply will result in regulatory sanctions.
