Job purpose

The job holder is responsible for assessing and managing risk by analyzing data, and other factors to determine appropriate pricing for reinsurance products. To design and evaluate contracts, ensure financial reserves are adequate and assist in regulatory compliance.

Primary responsibilities

1. Prepare Statutory regulatory returns addressing areas such as capital adequacy, technical provisions, and retrocession arrangements, claim reserves and pricing of risks.

- 2. Undertake risk analysis on existing and new reinsurance contracts and evaluate their potential profitability.
- 3. Assist in undertaking research, training and actuarial valuations.
- 4. Participate and contribute in development of new reinsurance products and other innovations in the corporation.
